

**Phytoplankton abundance:**

$3.1 \times 10^4$  cells ml<sup>-1</sup>

**Long-term average (June, 1984-2018):**

$2.0 \times 10^3 \pm 0.9 \times 10^3$  cells ml<sup>-1</sup>

**Phytoplankton groups percentage:**

diatoms: 68.2%, flagellates: 28.9%,

dinoflagellates: 2.5%, coccolithophores: 0.4%

**Most abundant taxa:**

*Chaetoceros* single sp. (40.9%)

*Chaetoceros tenuissimus* (3.3%)

**Most abundant species in the net sample:**

Naked dinoflagellates <15 μm

*Cyclotella gracilis*
